CHAIR

- Face of the Council
- Presides over meetings

VICE CHAIR


- Acts as Chair in the Chair's absence

PARLIAMENTARIAN

- Ensures adherence to Open Meetings Law & Robert's Rules

- Officers are elected by SGC members at the 1st meeting of the Fiscal Year.
- Officers serve a 1-year term & are eligible for 1 additional 1-year term
- Cannot be the Principal or a Student member.

- + **Responsibilities**

 - Conduct community/stakeholder surveys
